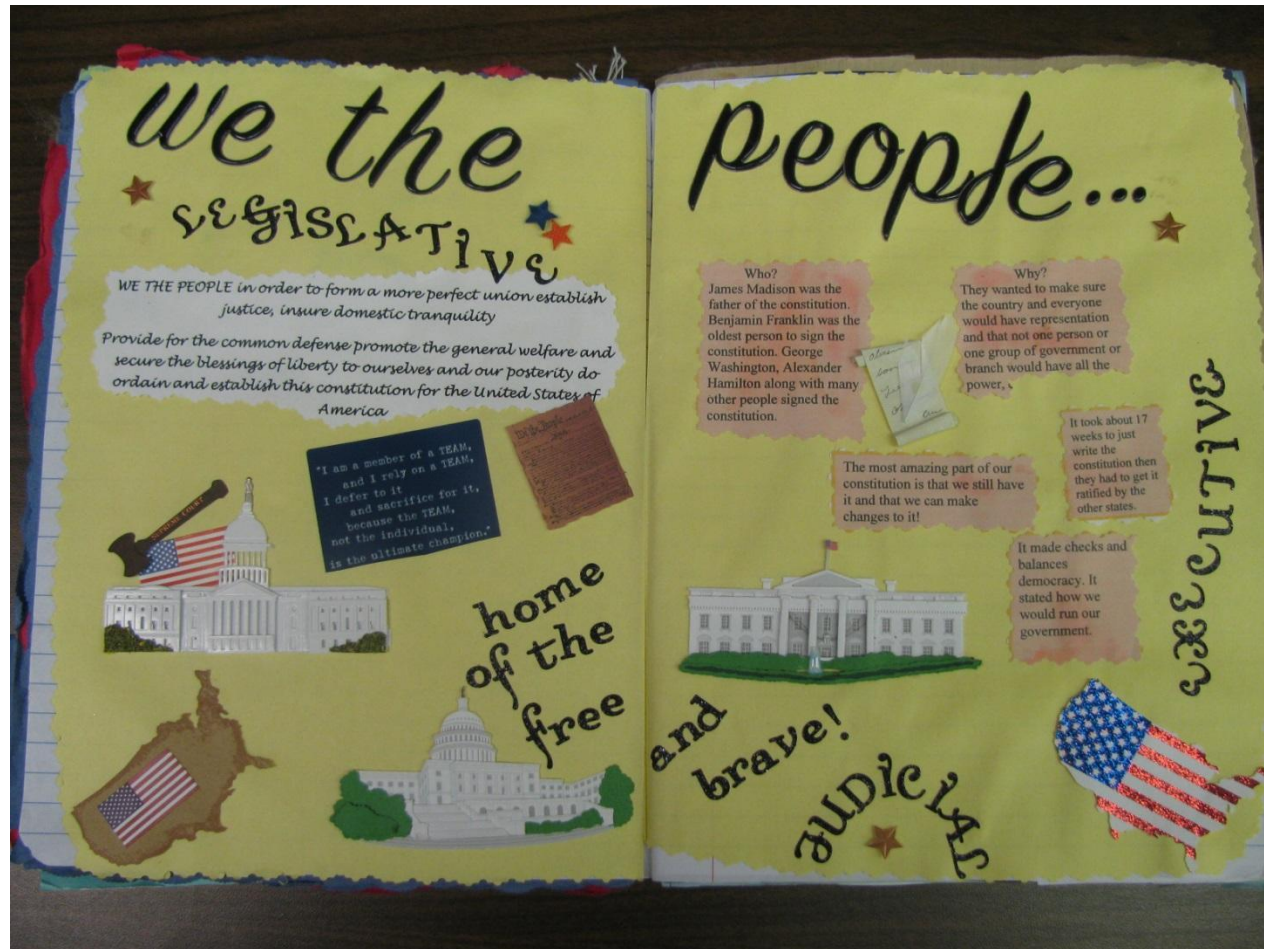

The Native Americans made a Peace Maker Belt to show peace between them and the Quakers.



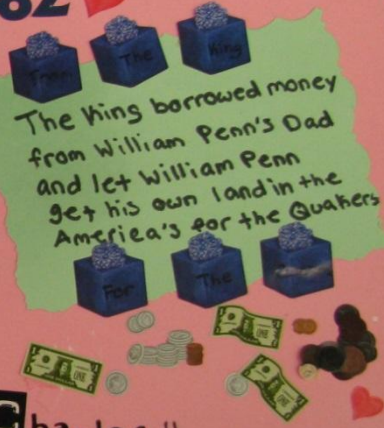
QUAKERS
